AIDS - ALASKA


Through December 31, 1993, 204 Alaskans have been confirmed to have AIDS. Of the 204 AIDS cases, 182 are in males and 22 in females. Data below employ the 1993 Expanded Case Definition for AIDS. All cases are shown as diagnosed in the year the person first met the revised case definition. Residence at time of diagnosis is shown by census area.
