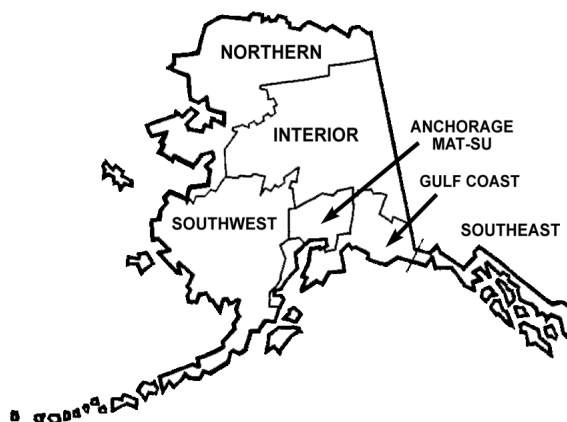

\*\*HIV infection became reportable in 1999. Cases reported in 1999 include cases diagnosed in earlier years and persons who did not reside in Alaska at the time of their diagnosis.

No cases of the following reportable diseases were reported during the above periods:

- anthrax, plague, rabies (human), Reye syndrome, smallpox,
- typhoid fever, typhus and yellow fever.

Since only a portion of all reportable illnesses is reported, these figures represent trends rather than actual incidence. More complete reporting of cases to the Division of Public Health will result in more accurate statistics. The above figures represent both

military and civilian reporting.
