## Summary of HIV Infection in Alaska, 1982-2006


A cumulative total of 1,145 cases of HIV infection were reported to the Alaska Section of Epidemiology through December 31, 2006, including 49 cases newly diagnosed during 2006. Of the 1,145:

- 805 (70%) were reported with AIDS and 340 (30%) were reported with HIV infection without AIDS;
- 927 (81%) were male; and
- 370 (32%) are known to have died.




**Cumulative Number of HIV Cases and Known Deaths by Year of First Known HIV Diagnosis through December 31, 2006 (N=1,145)**




**Number of HIV Cases through December 31, 2006 by Age at Diagnosis (N=1,145)**
